Whether you're new to split HPWH systems or sharpening your skills, this event is built for you. Join us for an immersive learning experience in the future of water heating.

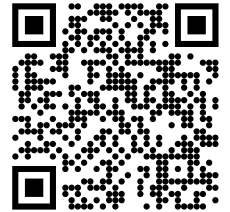
